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1. What instructional options will EFISD offer during the 2020-2021 school year?

EFISD will offer 2 instructional options for 2020-2021, depending on grade level –

- 1) On-Campus Instruction – Students will attend school on the EFISD campuses and receive instruction from EFISD staff members. This option is available for grades Pre-Kindergarten – 12th Grade.
- 2) Virtual Instruction – Students will be enrolled in EFISD and receive their instruction virtually. This option is available for grades PreK – 12th Grade.

2. How do I enroll my child in virtual instruction or face to face instruction?

You must complete and submit the “Parent Commitment Form”.

The completed form must be submitted online or to the campus principal by **Wednesday, July 29, 2020 at 8:00 am.**

3. Can a student change from virtual learning to face to face?

Yes, a student may change their choice of instruction but only at the end of a six-week grading period.

The following deadlines apply to inform the school of your intent to switch from virtual instruction or face to face instruction.

You must talk to the campus principal to switch your child.

Deadlines to inform the school of your intentions to switch virtual or face to face instruction.

1st 6 Weeks (August 10, 2020 – September 18, 2020) – **Deadline is Wednesday, August 5, 2020 @ 12:00 pm**

2nd 6 Weeks (September 21, 2020 – October 30, 2020) – Deadline is Monday, September 14, 2020

3rd 6 Weeks (November 2, 2020 – December 18, 2020) – Deadline is Monday, October 26, 2020

4th 6 Weeks (January 4, 2021 – February 11, 2021) – Deadline is Monday, December 14, 2020

5th 6 Weeks (February 16, 2021 – April 1, 2021) – Deadline is Monday, February 8, 2021

6th 6 Weeks (April 5, 2021 – May 14, 2021) – Deadline is Monday, March 29, 2021

4. What kind of a device will I need for my student if I enroll them in virtual instruction?

A cell phone is not going to be sufficient for your child to successfully complete virtual instruction. Ideally, you

will need a laptop or desktop computer.

If you have multiple children in your home, you will need multiple devices in order for each child to meet the daily attendance requirements.

5. Will the school provide internet for my student if I enroll them in virtual instruction?

No.

6. Will internet be required for students enrolled in virtual instruction?

Yes. For a student to be successfully enrolled in virtual instruction and to be able to meet the attendance/engagement requirements outlined later in this document, the student must have reliable access to high-speed internet daily.

7. Will “At Home Learners” be eligible for extracurricular activities?

If students elect to participate in “At Home Learning,” they will not be eligible to participate in any extracurricular activities during that time.

8. How will attendance be taken for At Home Learners”?

Students will have to check in on Google Classroom or SeeSaw every single day, for every single class, in order to be counted present for that day.

9. Will students still have P.E. and recess?

Yes. Access to PE class is a requirement by law and recess is an important part of the learning process.

10. Will students and teachers have to wear masks?

Yes. Students will be asked to wear a mask. Teachers and staff will be required to wear masks.

11. May students bring water bottles to school?

Yes. Students may bring water bottles to school.

12. Do students that select At-Home Learning need to purchase school supplies?

Yes. Students will need school supplies for At-Home Learning. Their school supplies are to be left at home and do not need to be brought to the school.
